Academic Standing Rules for Undergraduate Students

All undergraduate students must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 to remain in good standing.

Students will be given academic probation if their cumulative g.p.a is below 2.0 and/or have not completed 67% or more of enrolled classes in a given term. Probation may be carried on for **one** more additional term. Once a student returns to good academic standing, students are removed from probationary status.

While on probation, students may be restricted to no more than 13 enrolled hours until good academic standing is achieved.
