Dear Civil Engineering and Associated Departments,

Qualifications

- Must be currently enrolled in an ABET-accredited Ohio university pursuing a 4-year undergraduate degree in Civil Engineering
- Must have attained sophomore status at time of application

Criteria for Selection

- Candidates must exhibit community and school involvement
- Work experience, volunteer experience, and leadership will be considered in the selection process
- College grade point average

Application Process

Applicants shall submit the following:

- ABCD Scholarship Application
- College transcript (an unofficial transcript may be included with the application; however, an official transcript must be provided prior to award of scholarship)
- A list of at least three references, including names, addresses and telephone numbers. References must be non-relatives, and at least one reference must be personal, and one must be collegiate.
- Personal Statement/Essay in 500 words or less, explain your interest in a bridge engineering career, and how you believe you can make a contribution to the transportation field. Relate your participation in extracurricular activities, including community and school involvement and work/volunteer experience.

Scholarship Recipient

- Recipient will be notified by December 21, 2021.
- Recipient should plan on attending one of the ABCD Chapter meetings after the scholarship award.
